Silk Hydra-Fix Soap (75g) **Directions for Use - Wash First**



1. Wet the affected area with warm (not hot) water.
2. Build up a lather with the hands - apply to affected area through gentle massaging with fingers.
3. Rinse with warm (not hot) water.
4. Dab dry with a clean natural fibre (Cotton for example) towel.

Silk Hydra-Fix Moisturising Cream (50g)



Directions for Use - Hydrate and Moisturise

1. After cleansing affected area, apply cream with clean fingers by massaging in gently.
2. Only small quantities are required. For guidance, a pea-sized amount will cover the palm and fingers of both hands.
3. Apply morning and night and additionally in the daytime/night time should itching or inflammation recur.

Repeat above procedure until skin has fully recovered. Improvements should be seen within a few days with the inflammation and itching rapidly suppressed. Expect 2-3 weeks for full restoration of skin. Thereafter apply cream daily to the affected area in order to maintain a natural, healthy skin barrier function.
